Nominations for Board Positions

As a reminder:

2. The member being nominated must be in good standing.
3. The person that is nominated must indicate a willingness to serve either in person or by a letter of intent.

3. Or, attend the June 19, 2021 board meeting at 9 am. If your nominee is not present, provide the letter of intent to serve from the nominee.
4. Mail or email nominations must be received by June 16, 2021.
5. You must be a member in good standing to be nominated.

Nominations received by mail or email will be presented at the June 19, 2021 board meeting by the election committee.
